
ACIDS and BASES

Acidity and Alkalinity

- Acidity: The level of an acid in a substance
- Alkalinity: The level of a base in a substance
- Acids and bases are measured on the **pH** scale



How to identify acids and bases

- Use an indicator such as litmus paper, red cabbage juice, grape juice, tea, etc...
- Indicators react in the presence of acidic or basic substances.
- Simplest method : Litmus paper test
- Two parts to the test
 - Red Litmus paper reaction
 - Blue Litmus paper reaction

Litmus Paper Test

	Acid	Neutral	Base
Red litmus reaction	Paper stays red	Paper stays red	Paper turns blue
Blue litmus reaction	1	Paper stays blue	Paper stays blue

Liquid A is: NEUTRAL Α

Liquid B is: ACID В
